Dear Commissioners:

This tariff filing is transmitted to you by Alaska Pacific Environmental Services Anchorage, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) in compliance with the Alaska Public Utilities Regulatory Act and 3 AAC 48.200 – 3 AAC 48.430 and the Commission’s directives for informational tariff filings issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6).

Alaska Waste, through its undersigned consultants, revises the following tariff sheets:

With this filing, Alaska Waste modifies its commercial fuel surcharges which apply to all commercial refuse collection services including hourly rates involving vehicle time such as standby time with the exception of per pound landfill charges for Roll-On/Roll-Off customers in the following service areas: Anchorage, Eagle River, Whittier, Portage, Girdwood and the Mat-Su Borough.

When Alaska Waste first filed a tariff to implement commercial fuel surcharges in April of this year, it stated that it would continue to monitor its fuel costs, national indexes and local conditions and determine appropriate adjustments to the surcharges. Since that time the cost of diesel fuel rose sharply through the summer then began to decline in the fall of this year. Alaska Waste’s current fuel costs have decreased since its last fuel surcharge adjustment that was implemented on November 1, 2008. This filing reflects a

decrease to the commercial fuel surcharge in Anchorage, Eagle River, Whittier, Girdwood and Portage from 7.5% to 7.1%. In the Mat-Su Borough service area the commercial fuel surcharge will decrease from 10.5% to 8.7%.

Alaska Waste will continue to monitor its diesel fuel prices over the next several months and update its fuel surcharges appropriately.

This tariff revision also makes changes to the holidays listed in the definitions section of the tariff. Martin Luther King Day and the day after Thanksgiving Day have been added and Veterans Day has been removed.

Conclusion

Alaska Waste submits this tariff as an informational filing pursuant to directives issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6), which exempt commercial refuse service from economic regulation and require informational tariff filings for commercial service. According to the Stipulation approved by that order, the Commission will not review tariff rates but will use tariff filings by commercial refuse utilities to confirm that all customers within a customer class are being treated equally, have notice of the rates to be charged for specific services, and that service will be provided in a safe, reasonable and non-discriminatory manner. Informational tariffs are generally allowed to go into effect after a thirty (30) day notice period to the public.

This filing will decrease commercial rates but will not result in the termination of an existing service, conflict with any other schedule or rate, or will not in any other way adversely affect customers, or the public. This filing has no impact on regulated residential customer rates.

Alaska Waste expects that this tariff will go into effect after a thirty (30) day notice period to the public, or for bills rendered on or after February 1, 2009. Alaska Waste will inform the customers impacted by this fuel surcharge by publishing a notice in the Anchorage Daily News. The public notice is included with this filing as Attachment A.

DEFINITIONS

"DUMPSTER" When used in this tariff refers to a dumpster container which has a capacity of not less than 1.5 cubic yards or more than 10 cubic yards and which can be mechanically emptied into a refuse truck from the front or rear of the truck.

"DUMPSTER COMPACTED" Refers to the pickup of compacted refuse (see "Compacted" above) placed in a special Dumpster having the capacity of no more than eight (8) cubic yards.

"EXTRA LARGE CONTAINER or ROLL-ON/ROLL-OFF SERVICE" An extra large container is a roll-off box which is no less than 10 cubic yards in size and which is suitable for mechanical loading onto and unloading off of the equipment of the utility.

"HAZARDOUS WASTE" Refers to refuse not acceptable for disposal in Utility's containers, refuse trucks or the Borough Landfills; including but not limited to toxic wastes, paint, paint thinners, grease, oil, batteries, aerosol cans, animal or human waste.

"INSTALLATION" Any activity required by the Utility that in order to initiate, rearrange, delete or otherwise provide or modify service or facilities provided to the general public.

"JUNKED MATERIAL" That material(s) which is not thought of, defined as, or considered as residential refuse, in the opinion of the Utility, such as, (but not limited to) automobiles, demolition material, metal, heavy appliances and furniture, and/or parts thereof; yard waste, sewage, animal, human and other putrescible wastes.

NOTICE OF INFORMATIONAL TARIFF FILING

Alaska Pacific Environmental Services Anchorage, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) hereby gives notice that on December 31, 2008 it filed TA22-692 with the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (Commission). With this informational tariff revision, Alaska Waste decreases its commercial fuel surcharge from 7.5% to 7.1% for its commercial customers in Anchorage, Eagle River, Girdwood, Portage, and Whittier and from 10.5% to 8.7% in the Mat-Su Borough to recover its fuel costs related to commercial refuse service. This surcharge applies to all commercial refuse collection charges (with the exception of landfill charges for Roll-On/Roll-Off customers) including hourly rates involving vehicle time such as standby time. This tariff revision also makes changes to the holidays defined in the Alaska Waste tariff. Alaska Waste expects this tariff will become effective on February 1, 2009.
