in the Kenai and Soldotna Service Areas

Dear Commissioners:

This tariff filing is transmitted to you by Alaska Waste – Kenai Peninsula, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) in compliance with the Alaska Public Utilities Regulatory Act and 3 AAC 48.200 – 3 AAC 48.430.

Alaska Waste, through its undersigned consultants, requests permission to amend the interim and refundable residential fuel surcharge to take into effect current fuel costs. The following tariff sheet has been revised:

In TA3-714, Alaska Waste filed a petition to implement a fuel surcharge of 6.7% for residential customers in the Kenai/Soldotna service area. Alaska Waste also committed to submitting updated fuel surcharge tariff advice filings on a quarterly basis for the Regulatory Commission of Alaska's (Commission) review that would incorporate fluctuations in diesel prices. On November 3, 2008, the Commission issued Letter Order No. LO800524 granting Alaska Waste's request to implement an interim and refundable fuel surcharge, pending the filing of its revenue requirement and cost of service studies due on July 2, 2009.

With this filing, Alaska Waste requests adjustment to its residential fuel surcharge which applies to all residential refuse collection services including extra can and bag charges for the Kenai/Soldotna service area.

Diesel fuel prices rose sharply through the summer then began to decline in the fall of 2008. Alaska Waste's current fuel costs have decreased since its last fuel surcharge adjustment which was filed on January 15, 2009. This filing reflects a decrease to the residential fuel surcharge for the Kenai/Soldotna service area from 5.3% to 1.6%.

Submitted with this filing as Attachment A is the fuel surcharge calculation for the Kenai/Soldotna service area. This calculation reflects a quarterly update of the average cost of fuel per gallon which was submitted in TA7-714. The average cost of diesel fuel for the Kenai/Soldotna service area has decreased from \$4.75 per gallon to \$3.48 per gallon during the period of January through March 2009. This calculation translates to a decrease for the residential fuel surcharge.

This tariff filing will affect all residential customers in the Kenai/Soldotna service area. Currently, Alaska Waste has 755 residential customers in this area that generate annual revenues of approximately \$219,000. The residential fuel surcharge will increase these revenues by approximately \$3,500 per year.

Alaska Waste requests that this tariff filing be allowed to go into effect on May 29, 2009 to coincide with its billing cycle and give residential customers the benefit of lower fuel surcharge fees as soon as possible. Alaska Waste requests adequate advance notification from the Commission in order to allow it to adjust the fuel surcharge to quarterly bills rendered on or after May 29, 2009.

This filing is not for a new service. This filing will decrease customer rates on an interim and refundable basis by adjusting the fuel surcharge to residential customers' monthly charges in the Kenai/Soldotna service area. This filing will not result in the termination of an existing service, conflict with any other schedule or rate, or in any other way adversely affect customers, or the public.


