Commercial Fuel Surcharge Decrease in the Fairbanks North Star Borough

Dear Commissioners:

This tariff filing is transmitted to you by Alaska Waste – Interior, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) in compliance with the Alaska Public Utilities Regulatory Act and 3 AAC 48.200 – 3 AAC 48.430 and the Regulatory Commission of Alaska’s (Commission) directives issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6).

Alaska Waste, through its undersigned consultants, proposes revisions to the following tariff sheets:

With this filing, Alaska Waste modifies its commercial fuel surcharge that applies to all refuse collection services for its commercial customers in the Fairbanks North Star Borough. The fuel surcharge applies to Commercial Can, Dumpster, and Roll-On/Roll-Off Container service.

Alaska Waste has reviewed its fuel costs that contribute to the provision of commercial services in the Fairbanks North Star Borough and believes that a fuel surcharge reduction is warranted. The current commercial fuel surcharge is 4.4% and will be reduced to 3.1%. Alaska Waste will continue to monitor its fuel cost, trends and local conditions and consider future adjustments to the surcharge as warranted by the circumstances.

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Alaska Waste submits this tariff as an informational filing pursuant to directives issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6), which exempt commercial refuse service from economic regulation and require informational tariff filings for commercial service. According to the Stipulation approved by that order, the Commission will not review tariff rates but will use tariff filings by commercial refuse utilities to confirm that all customers within a customer class are being treated equally, have notice of the rates to be charged for specific services, and that service will be provided in a safe, reasonable and non-discriminatory manner. Informational tariffs are generally allowed to go into effect after a thirty (30) day notice period to the public.

This filing will decrease commercial rates but will not result in the termination of an existing service, conflict with any other schedule or rate, or will not in any other way adversely affect customers or the public. This filing has no impact on regulated residential customer rates.

Alaska Waste expects that this tariff will go into effect following a thirty (30) day notice period to the public, or for bills rendered on or after May 1, 2009. Alaska Waste will inform the customers impacted by this fuel surcharge by publishing a notice in the Fairbanks Daily News Miner. The public notice is included with this filing as Attachment A.



Alaska Waste – Interior, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) hereby gives notice that on March 31, 2009 it filed TA19-667 with the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (Commission). This informational tariff filing decreases the Alaska Waste commercial fuel surcharge assessed to Commercial Can, Dumpster and Roll-On/Roll-Off customers in the Fairbanks North Star Borough from 4.4% to 3.1%. Alaska Waste expects this filing to go into effect on May 1, 2009.
