Re: Alaska Waste Mat-Su, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste
 Commercial Rate Increase for the Mat-Su Borough Service Area

Dear Commissioners:

This tariff filing is transmitted to you by Alaska Pacific Environmental Services Anchorage, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste) on behalf of Alaska Waste Mat-Su, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste in compliance with the Alaska Public Utilities Regulatory Act and 3 AAC 48.200 – 3 AAC 48.430 and the Regulatory Commission of Alaska’s (Commission) directives for informational tariff filings issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6).

On March 31, 2009, Alaska Waste and Alaska Waste Mat-Su, LLC d/b/a Alaska Waste (Alaska Waste Mat-Su) filed a joint application for a new certificate of public convenience and necessity for transfer of the Mat-Su Borough service area. A new certificate of public convenience and necessity was granted to Alaska Waste Mat-Su in Order No. U-09-27(3), dated October 27, 2009. Order No. U-09-27(3) also approved Alaska Waste Mat-Su’s Tariff Adoption Notice filed on October 13, 2009, which adopted the Alaska Waste tariff.

In July 2009, Alaska Waste filed a request for a permanent residential rate increase for the Mat-Su Borough service area. Alaska Waste has also experienced increased expenses related to its commercial operations.

With this filing, Alaska Waste makes multiple changes to its commercial rates. The Mat-Su Borough service area is very large; therefore, Alaska Waste has developed three geographic zones to better reflect the cost of serving customers throughout this service area. Alaska Waste increases its current dumpster service rates by 1.0% and adds rates for up to five pick-ups per week for 4, 6 and 8 cubic yard containers in addition to adding dumpster rates for the second and third commercial zones. Alaska Waste also makes changes to the roll-on/roll-off service. Alaska Waste will provide roll-on/roll-off container service for containers having a capacity of 15-40 cubic yards at a single flat rate for each zone. Roll-on/roll-off service customers will also have the option of electing to subscribe to hook lift container service in lieu of roll-on/roll-off container service. All commercial customers located outside the boundaries of Zone 3 will incur an additional charge of \$3.50 per mile round trip. Finally, Alaska Waste increases the charges for additional pickup service and adds zoned rates for occasional or unscheduled pickups. There are no commercial can customers, so Alaska Waste has removed this service from its tariff.

Alaska Waste submits this tariff as an informational filing pursuant to directives issued in Order Nos. U-07-32(6)/U-07-33(5)/U-07-34(5)/U-07-35(5)/U-07-36(6), which exempt commercial refuse service from economic regulation and require informational tariff filings for commercial service. According to the Stipulation approved by that order, the Commission will not review tariff rates but will use tariff filings by commercial refuse utilities to confirm that all customers within a customer class are being treated equally, have notice of the rates to be charged for specific services, and that service will be provided in a safe, reasonable and non-discriminatory manner. Informational tariffs are generally allowed to go into effect after a thirty (30) day notice period to the public.

This filing will increase commercial service rates but will not result in the termination of an existing service, conflict with any other schedule or rate, or will not in any other way adversely affect customers, or the public.

Alaska Waste expects that this tariff will go into effect after a thirty (30) day notice period to the public, or for bills rendered on or after March 31, 2010. Alaska Waste will inform the customers impacted by this commercial rate increase filing by publishing a notice in the Anchorage Daily News. 
